**ANCILLARY SCHEDULING ORDER**

Pursuant to Rule 16 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court issues the following scheduling order to address issues relating to intervenor Clovis Capital Ventures, LLC’s purported security interest.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Non-party Amegy Bank National Association must file a motion to intervene, if any, on or before Friday, October 24, 2014.
2. The parties shall serve, but not file with the Court, proposed discovery requests on all other parties on or before Wednesday, October 29, 2014.
3. The parties must make any objections to the proposed discovery requests on or before Monday, November 3, 2014.
4. The parties must file any unresolved discovery disputes with the Court on or before December 24, 2014.

5. The parties shall complete discovery on or before December 31, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.
6. The parties shall file a report on alternative dispute resolution on the above issue in compliance with Local Rule CV-88 on or before January 7, 2015.
7. The parties shall file written briefs on the above issue on or before January 14, 2015.

The undersigned hereby **ORDERS** the parties to appear for a motion hearing on **January 21, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.** in Courtroom No. 8, on the Seventh Floor of the United States Courthouse, 501 West Fifth Street, Austin, Texas 78701. The motion hearing will address the matter set forth above.

The Court **FURTHER ORDERS** that, in preparation for the motion hearing, the parties shall comply with the applicable bench trial provisions of Local Rule CV-16(e)–(g) of the Local Rules of the Western District of Texas.
