**ORDER PERMITTING PRO SE DEFENDANT JANNIECE S. KAELIN  
TO REGISTER WITH CM/ECF SYSTEM**

This matter came before the Court this 3rd day of March, 2014, on the motion of Defendant Janniece S. Kaelin ("Kaelin"), requesting that the Court allow Movant to register as a Filing User in the CM/ECF system used by the Court.
