ORDER


Before the court in the above-number and styled cause is Charles Martin Kaelin's "Opposed Motion to Set Aside Order Based on Mistake" filed June 3, 2014 (Clerk's Doc. No. 82). Mr. Kaelin, a debtor with bankruptcy proceedings currently pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Western District of Texas, Austin Division, is married to Defendant Janniece S. Kaelin and is not

a party to this action. Mr. Kaelin filed the above-listed motion asking the court to set aside its May 27, 2014 Order (Clerk's Doc. No. 80). Mr. Kaelin represents that his "Motion to Enforce Automatic Stay Against Receiver and for Emergency Hearing" filed May 27, 2014 (Clerk's Doc. No. 73) was filed to inform the court that he had requested relief from the bankruptcy court and was not intended to seek relief from this court. Instead, Mr. Kaelin asks that his "Motion to Enforce" serve as notice of his bankruptcy filing.

On May 27, 2014 this court held a hearing on several pending motions, including Mr. Kaelin's, which was filed that day. Representatives for the Plaintiff and the Receiver stated on the record in open court that they were on notice of Mr. Kaelin's bankruptcy proceedings. For this reason, Mr. Kaelin's current motion will be denied. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Kaelin's "Opposed Motion to Set Aside Order Based on Mistake" (Clerk's Doc. No. 82) is **DENIED**.
